2021-2022 Report

This report describes the activities of the Community and Legislative Affairs Committee for Academic Year 2021-2022. This report updates activities completed since the last report submitted in May 2021.

Our five goals for Academic Year 2021-2022 were set in August 2021. The goals were:

- 1. Continue meetings with Dr. Samory Pruitt's Office.
- 2. Keep Faculty Senate apprised of legislative developments.
- 3. Hold legislative reception.
- 4. Provide support for Brewer-Porch Children's Center with a teacher appreciation lunch.
- 5. Work to support the United Way's fundraising.

The following goals were completed this academic year:

1. Support of United Way.

Committee Co-Chair Steven Yates attended the United Way Kick-off in October 2021. We reminded Faculty Senators about the United Way campaign. UA reached the goal of \$400,000 in 2021.

2. Support of the Coat Drive benefitting Brewer-Porch.

We worked to promote the Professional Staff Assembly Coat Drive. Committee Co-Chair Joy Burnham coordinated this work.

3. <u>Legislative Delegation Relationships.</u>

Our committee enjoys a strong working relationship with Charlie Taylor, Director of Governmental Affairs and Economic/Workforce Development for the University of Alabama System. Steven communicated with Mr. Taylor throughout the year. The Faculty Senate Legislative Reception was held January 31, 2022. 4. UA Office of Community Affairs' Neighborhood Partnerships Committee.
